Literacy: We will learn the consonant digraph /ng/, 'sing a song.' We will explore sentence types including statements and questions. We will continue to master expanding our sentences, in the form of a recount, retell, and use specific vocabulary such as 'sing.'

Numeracy: In number we will continue to practise our counting patterns. We will identify ordinal positions on a number track (1st, 2nd, 3rd).

In measurement we will identify odd and even numbers to 10.

Religion: We will begin our unit on 'joy.'

Humanities: We will explore who is on our money?

RRRR: Gender and Identity - Who am I? Different things to know about me.



YEAR 1

Literacy: 'are', 'ere' making the /air/ sound; factual writing (porpoise and mammal)

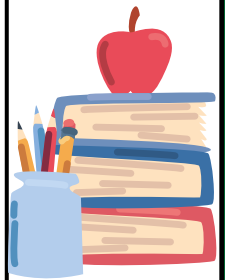
Numeracy: Identifying a target number using sharing and grouping, directions

Measurement: Capacity

RRRR: Positive Coping - Empathy & Gratitude.

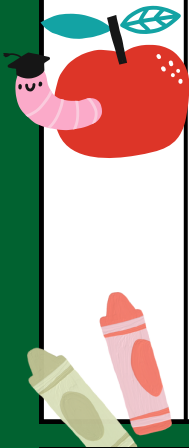


YEAR 2

Literacy: This term, we will be exploring Little Learners Love Literacy (LLLL) Stage 7.5. We will learn about the suffix ed. In writing, students will continue to develop their skills by creating detailed recounts, learning how to sequence events and include descriptive language.

Numeracy: Our focus this week will be on division. Students will build on their understanding of equal groups, sharing, and number facts to solve division problems using a range of strategies and representations.

Religion: We are beginning our new unit on Celebration. Students will explore how and why we celebrate within our Church and school community, and the special ways we give thanks and share joy through these occasions.



YEAR 3/4

Literacy:

Writing: This week we will be learning about appositives and exploring the recount genre.

- Monday & Tuesday: Recount writing lessons
- Wednesday & Thursday: Appositives focus
- Friday: Creative Writing.

Reading: We will begin an in-depth picture storybook study of Meet Sidney Nolan, learning about his life and the stories behind his art.

Mathematics: We will be investigating data, learning how to collect, organise, and represent information in different ways.

Humanities: This week's Art focus will continue our exploration of Sidney Nolan, connecting to our reading studies.

Religion: We will reflect on the 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time and commence our learning of the Gift unit.

RRRR: Positive Gender Relations

Literacy: Students will be revising persuasive writing sentences and paragraph structure.

Numeracy : Students will commence our new unit on data. Students will be learning how to collect, create and choose appropriate data displays.

Religion: In term four we are studying the concept of 'solidarity'. This means unity or agreement with a common interest.

Humanities: Students will explore the key institutions, roles and responsibilities of Australia's levels of government, along with its democratic values and beliefs.
